

Chinese Panda Rattle Drum Directions

Materials: 2 paper plates (6"), black construction paper, black marker, string, 2 beads, straw, tape, scissors, glue stick

Directions:

1. Begin your drum by drawing the pandas face on both paper plates (one the back side or bottom).

After you've drawn one face, place the other plate over top and trace.

2. Using the hole punch, punch a hole on either side of both plates. After you've












punched one plate, place the other plate over top, with the faces up, and punch the second plate.

This will line the holes up on both plates.

3. With the black piece of construction paper and white colored


pencil, draw your pandas ears.





Cut the ears out and glue them to the inside of one paper plate using the glue stick.

4. Use two pieces of tape to attach the straw to the inside of a plate. Tape the straw to the plate without ears.



5. Using the glue stick, glue the plate with ears onto the plate with the straw.

6. Where the straw comes out of the two plates, use two small pieces of tape to close the gap.


Circle around the plates with you finger to ensure they are stuck together.

7. Tie one bead to the end of each string with a double knot. After you're done tying, cut off excess string making sure you don't cut too close to the knot.

8. Take the strings with their beads and tie one into each hole on your panda. Make sure you don't cut excess string too close to the knot.

9. Your Chinese panda rattle drum is all done! Put the straw in between your hands and move them in a back and forth motion to make noise with your drum!
