

Make a Honey Bee Hive Pot

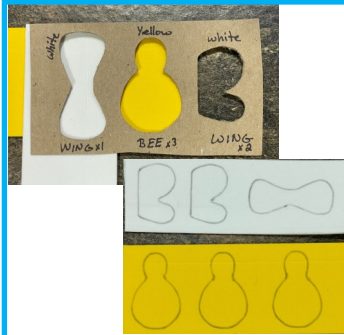


Honey Bee Hive Pot Directions

Materials: terra cotta pot, yellow and black paint, white and yellow craft foam, wire, twine, black marker, tacky glue, hot glue, paint brush



1. Start by painting your pot yellow. You will need 2-4 coats of paint. For the first coat, use the foam brush. After, use the smaller brush. Please bring your used foam brush to staff as soon as done using. In between dry times, move on to step 2.

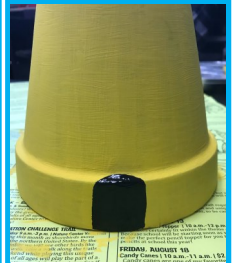


2. In between paint coats, trace the bee template on the yellow and white foam as the picture shows.

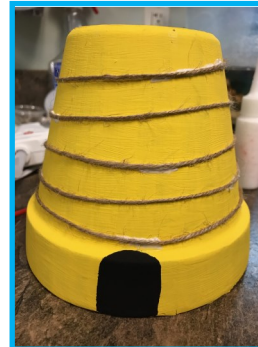
3. Cut out the bees. Continue painting your pot as it dries.



4. Draw stripes & face on your pot. Be careful as marker may smudge. Glue you bee together.



5. Paint the door shape on your pot with black paint.



6. Glue one end of twine to pot near the back bottom side. Wrap twine around and up the pot and glue the rest of the way with tacky glue.

7. Hot glue time! Adults Only!!!

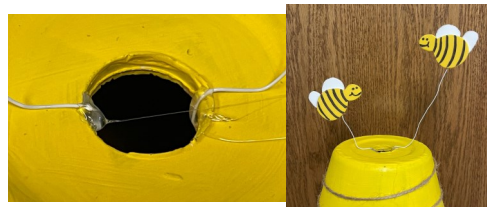
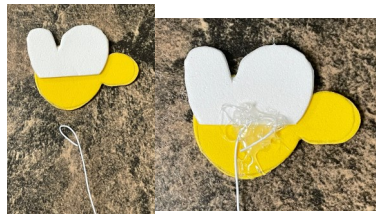
Take craft to the hot glue table.

A. Drop a glue dot on both ends of the twine to keep in place.

B. Glue single bee to side of pot.

C. Take wire and create a small loop. Use the hot glue to attach flying bees to each piece of wire.

D. Glue the end of each wire with hot glue to the center hole in the top of your pot.



8. Your Honey Bee Hive Pot is complete. Take it home to decorate your home or yard.
