

Make a Jaguar Mask

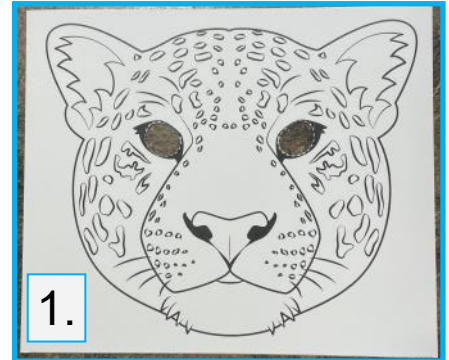


Jaguar Mask Directions

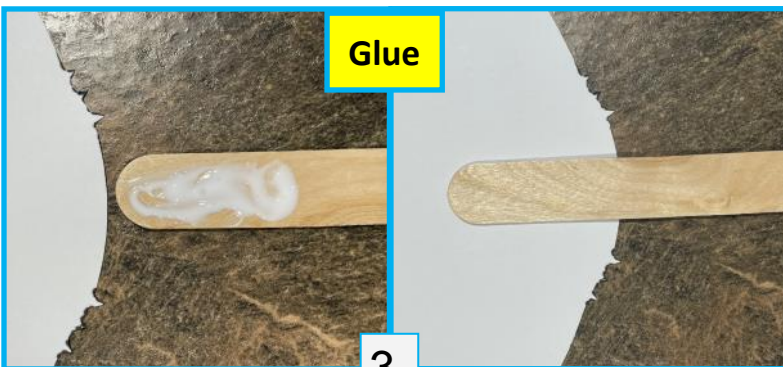
Materials: jaguar mask pattern, jumbo craft stick, colored pencils, glue/tape, & scissors

Directions:

1. Color your jaguar mask.
2. Cut out mask (eyes are already cutout).



3. Glue **OR** tape craft stick to back of mask near bottom of face. Let dry.



4. Use your mask to become a jungle jaguar!





Jaguars of Central & South America

These big cats are Near Threatened meaning they are closing in on becoming an endangered species due to loss of habitat. They can be found in forests and grasslands.

Jaguars are the third-largest cat in the world and can weight over 300 pounds and reach a length of 6 feet.

The name “jaguar” originates from the Tupi and Guarani languages of South America and the word yaguareté, or “true, fierce beast and he who kills in one leap.”



In many Latin-American cultures, the jaguar represents the power of nature and is seen as the protector of the rainforest.
