

Make a Paper Plate Toucan

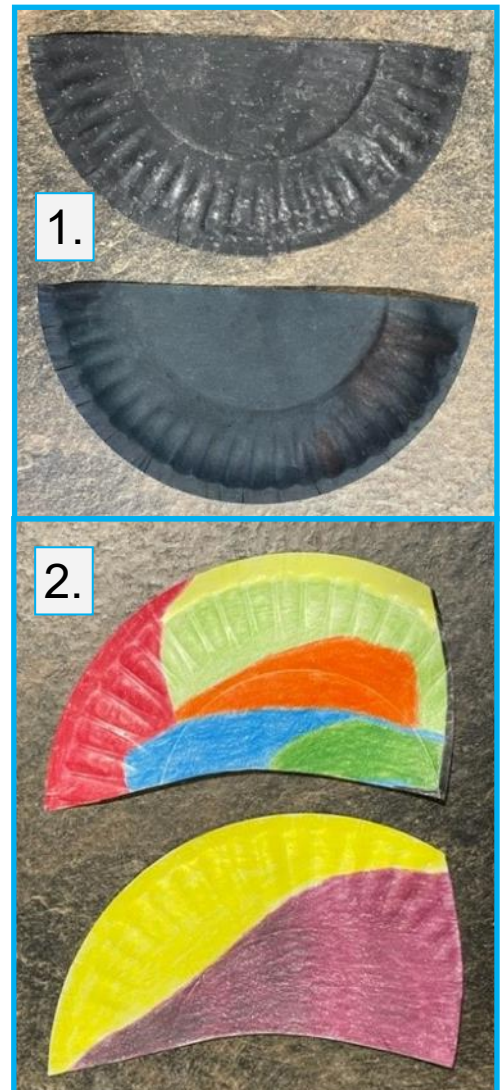


Paper Plate Toucan Directions

Materials: toucan black paper body, black paper tail, 1/2 small paper plate (wing), 1/2 small paper plate (beak), brown construction paper (feet), wiggle eye, yellow & red tissue paper, colored pencils, black crayon/marker, glue, & scissors

Directions:

1. The 1/2 paper plate without lines is the wing, color this 1/2 black using marker or crayons.
2. Take the 1/2 paper plate with marks and cut along the lines. This is the beak of our toucan. Color the beak. Toucans have colorful beaks!
3. Cut out the body, tail, and feet. On the body, only cut the white lines! (The yellow are for a later part.) Check out the picture.
4. Let's start gluing! Glue the tail onto the bottom right of the body. (Look at the image.) Then glue the feet at the bottom to the back side.



5. Use yellow tissue paper squares in the yellow-lined area at the head.

Loosely crumple

tissue paper slightly and glue on to the area, filling the space.

6. Use the red tissue paper squares in the lined area at the bottom area. Crumple and glue like step 5.

7. Glue on the colorful beak, wiggle eye, and black wing.

8. Hang your toucan at home! Toucans like to eat fruits, berries, lizards, rodents, frogs, small birds, and an assortment of insects!
