Make A Pipe Cleaner Snail





Pipe Cleaner Snail Directions


Materials: pipe cleaners, wiggle eyes, pencil, & glue

Directions:


- Start with the two pipe cleaners of same color. Bend one end around in a small circle. Repeat with the other same color pipe cleaner. These will be the eyes.
- 2. Measure 1.5 inches from the bottom of the eyes and start to twist the two same color pipe cleaners together, all the way to the end.
- 3. Using the single color pipe cleaner, wrap around a pencil all the way to the end and remove.
- 4. Place the coiled piece over the end of the double twisted pieces (at the non-







eyeball end). Move all the way till the two pipe cleaners separate.



5. Starting at the end of the two twisted pipe cleaners, start to roll them up and above the coiled pipe cleaner. This forms the snails shell.

You will have to play with

the layout of the snail some.

6. Twist the two eye ends to lay flat with the rest of the body. Glue the wiggle eyes at the top circles and let dry.

7. Enjoy your snail at home! Place a magnet on the back for the fridge or maybe attack to a popsicle stick and place in a planter.
